CROSS COUNTRY CARNIVAL

Students in Years 3 – 6 will compete at **Olds Park**, leaving school at 9:30am and walking with their class and their teacher. Everyone is asked to wear their school sports uniform with a shirt in the colour of their sport house i.e. Waratah wear red shirts, Wattle wear yellow and Bluegum wear blue. Students must wear their school hat, comfortable running shoes and a jacket/tracksuit pants that can easily be removed for the race if the

morning is cool. Students are also advised to bring a groundsheet or blanket to sit on. All students must take a water bottle, their crunch and sip, lunch and recess to the carnival. No canteen or lunch orders will be available. Students will not need to bring their iPads to school. Students with asthma should ensure that they have their asthma puffers with them for the carnival.

The carnival races will be held as soon as everyone arrives at the park and we are anticipating this to be by approximately 10:00am. Children who turn 8, 9 or 10 years old this year will run a course of 2km and children who turn 11, 12 & 13 will run a course of 3km. Parents and friends are invited to come and join us at Olds Park to cheer along the runners in each event.

At the completion of all the races, the students will walk back to Peakhurst PS with their class teacher.
