External Validation

Kindergarten 2021

It is that time of year when we ask for any enrolment forms for kindergarten for 2021 to be sent into the office. At the moment we are requesting that all applications be electronic. Under DEC guidelines we are unable to accept out of area applications. However, if your new enrolment is the sibling of a child already at Peakhurst, and you are out of area, please send your application to school for consideration.

Kindergarten 2021 enrolments due now

Enrolments for children that are beginning school next year are now due. Your child is eligible to enrol if they turn 5 years of age on or before 31 July 2021. The Education Act 1990 mandates that all children must be in compulsory schooling by 6 years of age.

Download the <u>Application to enrol in NSW Government school</u> form for students from Kindergarten to Year 12. The application form must be completed in English. However, a <u>translated application</u> to enrol may help you to fill out the form in English. As we are not having parents/carers on site these need to be completed and submitted to the school's email address: peakhurst-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au

Once your enrolment is completed, you will hear from the school regarding scheduling an interview to meet the Principal and Assistant Principal for Kindergarten in Term 3.

Changes to the opportunity class placement process for 2020 Year 4 students

The 2021 Year 5 opportunity class placement process was put on hold in April 2020 due to the COVID-19 situation.

We now have a revised and simplified timeline for the OC placement process to ensure that students and families can have certainty about their placement as soon as possible.

The changes include:

- A new date for online applications. Parents must apply between 9 June 2020 and 26 June 2020.
 Late applications cannot be accepted.
- A new test date Wednesday, 16 September 2020.

To ensure fair and consistent assessment of students across New South Wales, students will be offered places based only on their test results this year – there will be no school assessment scores.

There will also be no opportunity for appeals given the tight time frames.

Band Recommencement

Face to face band rehearsals and tutorials at school will be recommencing Week 1, Term 3. The following precautionary measures will be put in place:

- Students are encouraged to keep hand sanitizer in their instrument case to use before setting up and following packing up their instruments.
- Students must use one music stand each with their own music and if possible supply their own folding music stand.
- No sharing of instruments or equipment with the exception of percussion which will be played using the students own sticks.
- All music stands and equipment will need to be wiped down after each use.

- Brass players must use a hand towel/cloth on their laps for wiping off any moisture following playing.
- Students to be seated appropriately spaced if rooming allows.
- The conductor/tutor to be at the prescribed distance from students at all times.
- Tutors/ conductors to only attend if symptom free and not had contact with any infected person.
- School liaison teacher to be present to explain to students these guidelines and observe they are carried out.


