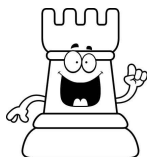

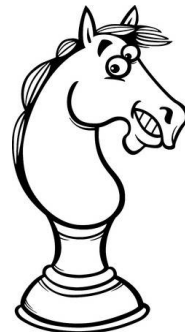
SELECTIVE HIGH SCHOOL APPLICATIONS
