UNIFORM POLICY

In order to prevent any misunderstandings, the following information is designed to help you purchase the correct uniform for your child. At Peakhurst Public School we believe that full school uniform should be worn at all times to present an image of pride to the wider community and for student safety and well being.

GIRLS UNIFORM

SUMMER

School summer tunic, white short socks, black shoes school hat.

WINTER

 Winter tunic or long navy blue school pants, short or long sleeved white school shirt, school sloppy joe with emblem, school tracksuit top with emblem, short white socks or navy blue tights, black shoes, school hat.

SPORT

- Yellow, blue and white sports shirt with emblem, navy blue netball skirt or navy blue unisex sport shorts, white short socks, runners, school hat.
- There are particular requirements for PSSA teams.
 Children will be informed of these requirements when teams are selected.
- The school tracksuit can be worn on Fridays for sport in cooler weather.



BOYS UNIFORM

SUMMER

Grey school shorts, navy blue polo shirt with emblem, grey short socks, black shoes, school hat [grey cargo pants are not part of the school uniform].

WINTER

 Long or short grey school pants, long or short sleeved navy blue polo shirt with emblem, school sloppy joe with emblem, school tracksuit top with emblem, short grey socks, black shoes, school hat.

SPORT

- Yellow, blue and white sport shirt with emblem, navy blue unisex sports shorts, white socks and runners, school hat.
- There are particular requirements for PSSA teams. Children will be informed of these requirements when teams are selected.
- The school tracksuit can be worn on Fridays for sport in cooler weather.



BOYS AND GIRLS

SCHOOL SHOES Plain black [no coloured stripes].

SOCKS

Grey short socks for boys and white short socks for girls. Anklet socks are not to be worn with the school uniform [White anklet socks may be worn with the sports uniform only]

ASSESSORIES

- No jewellery is to be worn other than watches, studs or sleepers.
- Coloured hair ties and scrunchies other than blue or yellow are not part of school uniform.
- Students are not permitted to wear T-shirts, long sleeve skivvies or leggings under the uniform.

SUNSAFE PROCEDURE

The aim of the policy is to ensure that all students attending Peakhurst Public School and all staff and volunteers working at Peakhurst Public School are protected throughout the year from the sun's harmful ultraviolet radiation (UVR).

The policy aims to promote sun safety and reduce exposure to UVR through:

- consideration of the school's outdoor environment,
- organisation of activities
- curriculum content, and
- education of students, staff and parents.

Implementation

School Outdoor Environment

- 1. Peakhurst Public School provides adequate outdoor shaded areas for the protection of children and staff. The need for more shaded areas will be monitored and assessed through the year. As funds become available, the school will provide additional shade areas.
- 2. Parents are required to provide a school hat for the children to wear.
- 3. Peakhurst Public School has a "NO HAT, NO PLAY" rule where students who do not bring a hat to school are required to stay in designated shade areas. This includes all sporting activities.
- 4. Students are expected to wear full school uniform. On days when school uniform is not compulsory, students are to wear clothing that covers shoulders and the midriff area.
- 5. Staff members practice sensible sun safe procedures.
- 6. Parents are asked to apply maximum protection sun block to their child's skin before arriving at school.
- 7. Parents are asked to provide a stick or roll-on sun block, to be kept in the children's bags for reapplication through the day.

Organisation of activities


8. Outdoor assemblies held between 11am and 3pm (DST) and 10am and 2pm (EST) will be held under shelter.

Curriculum

9. During Terms 1 and 4, students will be provided with sun safe education programs from the Personal Development/Health/Physical Education key learning area.

Education of students, staff and parents

10. During Terms 1 and 4, a 'sunsafe' update will be placed in the school's newsletter 'FOCUS' to inform and educate the school community.
